
# 2011 NCDA National Tournament

#### When: April 9 & 10, 2011

Location: Raymond B. Preston Health and Activity Center, Western Kentucky University, Bowling Green, Kentucky 42101



### From North on I-65

Take I-65 south to Bowling Green exit #28. US 68/80 becomes University Blvd. Continue until you reach Normal Drive. Turn left onto Preston Center/Tate Page Hall parking lot.

## From South on I-65

Take I-65 north to Bowling Green exit #20, ramp toward Bowling Green. Go approximately two miles and turn right onto University Blvd. Continue to the next light and turn left onto Normal Drive. At the next light, turn left into the Preston Center/Tate Page Hall parking lot.

### From Cumberland Parkway

Get onto I-65 South toward Nashville. Take first Bowling Take US 31-W south, which becomes US 68/80. Green exit (#28) by Corvette Museum. Take left onto Louisville Road which becomes University Blvd. Continue until you reach Normal Drive. Turn left at the first light Normal Drive. Turn left at the first light into the into the Preston Center/Tate Page Hall parking lot.

## From William H. Natcher Parkway

Take the first Bowling Green exit off the parkway, turning William H. Natcher Parkway. From the parkway, right off the exit ramp toward Bowling Green. Continue on take exit #5 to US 68/80. Turn right off the exit US 231 until intersecting with US 68/80 (the road stops at a light and you must turn right or left). Turn left onto Russellville Road. At the next light, turn right onto University Blvd. Continue to the next light and turn left onto Normal Drive. At the next light, turn left into the Preston Center/Tate Page Hall parking lot.
